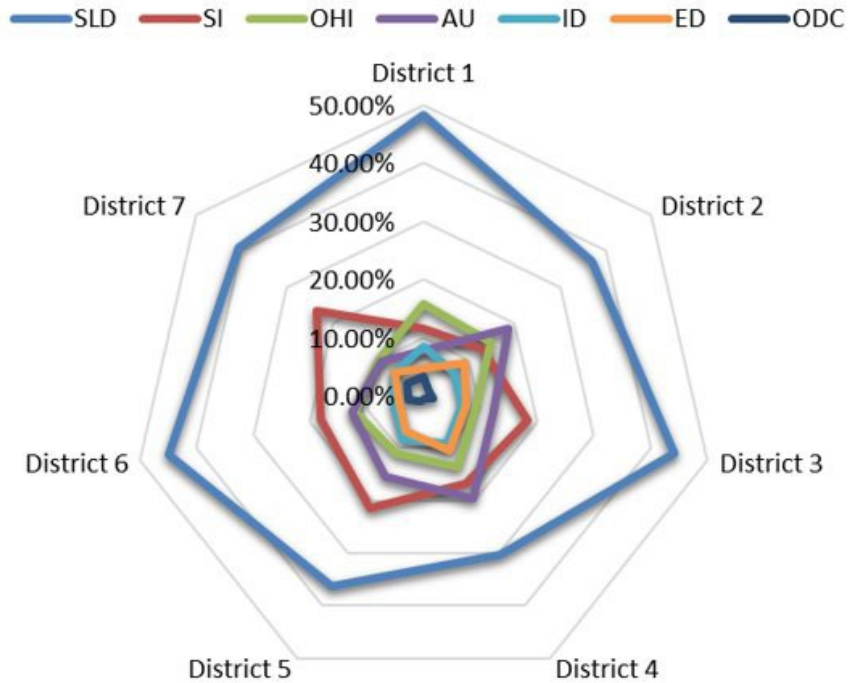

Disability Outcomes in a Public Charter School System

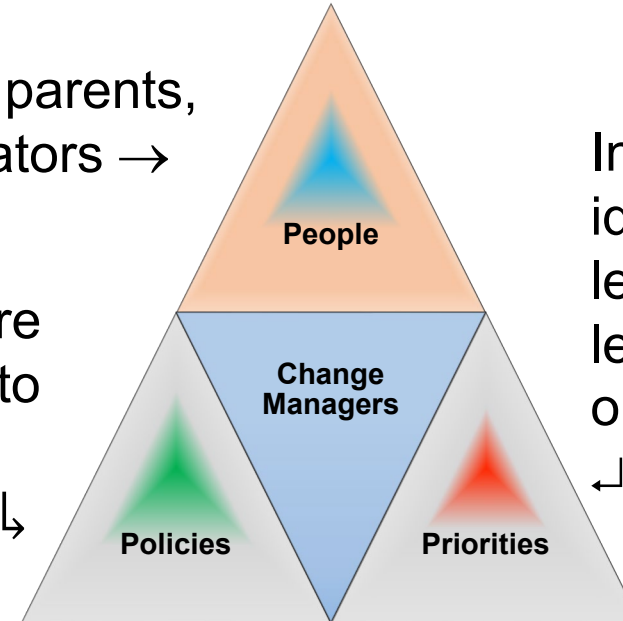
Primary Disability Conditions by Districts

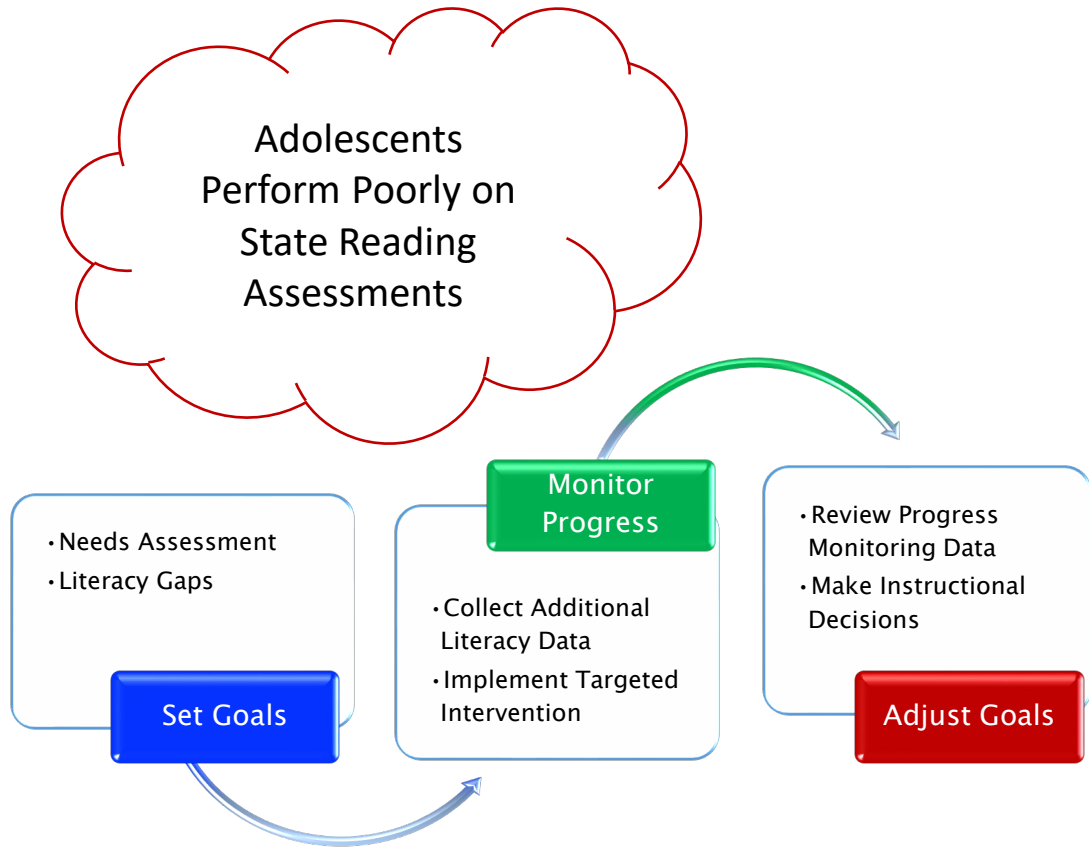

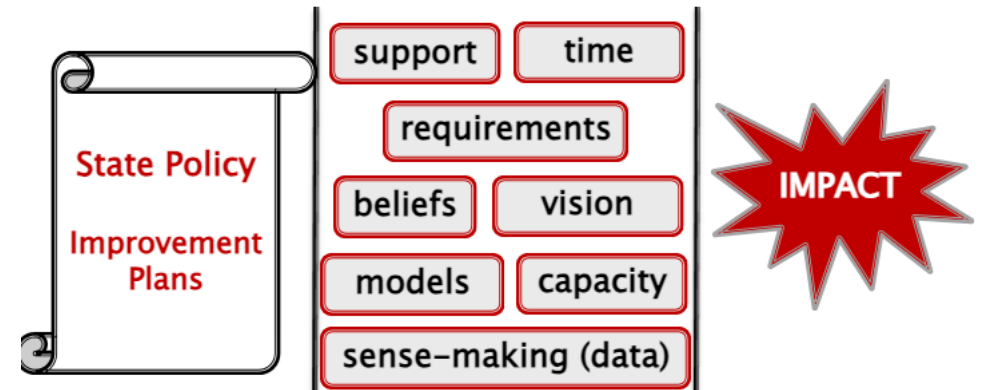

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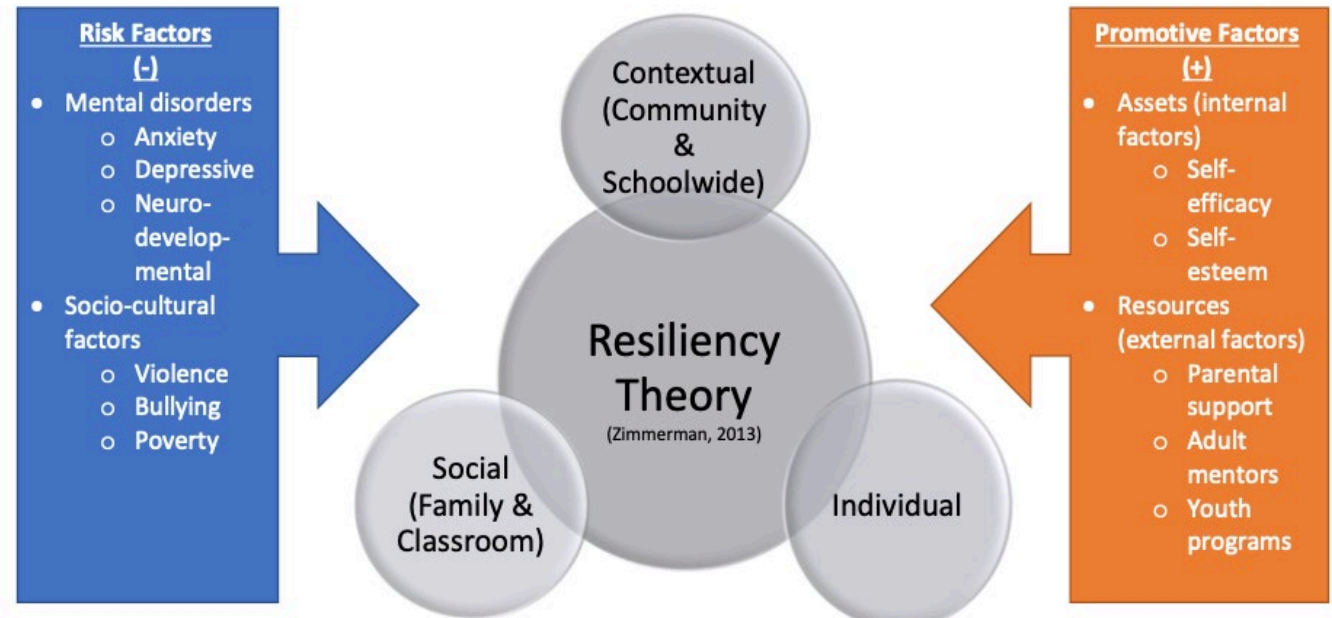




The impact of improvement plans is hindered by barriers during development, implementation, monitoring, and evaluation.
