- Indicator 8 parent involvement survey and IEP participation



Oklahoma SSIP Implementation

SSIP Part B

- SIMR: Improved early literacy achievement
- Measure: state-approved screening assessments
- State Intervention: professional development sequence and instructional coaching

SSIP Part C

- SIMR: Improved social and behavioral skills
- Measure: Ages and Stages Questionnaire
- State Intervention: implementation of the Pyramid Model and practitioner coaching


