Cross-cutting Reminders

Section 618 data submissions - States are expected to submit high-quality 618 data that can be published and used by the Department as of the applicable due date.

 Data submitted as of the due date are prefilled in the SPP/APR online submission tool for the applicable indicators.

Radio buttons are important – States are expected to check the applicable radio buttons when reporting on each indicator

 Failing to check radio buttons can affect the validity and reliability of data It can also affect how the SPP/APR online submission tool displays data

- Building capacity of diverse groups of parents
- Focus on engagement, not increasing #s or providing information

REPRESENTATIVENESS, RESPONSE RATE & NONRESPONSE BIAS

- Improving representativeness of data
- Strategies to increase response rate in underrepresented populations
- Analyzing data for nonresponse bias --- who did not respond, who was underrepresented and did those groups respond differently

CORRECTION OF NONCOMPLIANCE

- Discrepancies in State submissions when describing the verification of noncompliance
- Responsiveness to Prior Required Actions
